We aim to provide a rich and deep curriculum shaped by our three drivers: Eco (love for the environment), Christian values and Diversity (celebrating different cultures and beliefs). We are proud to hold the silver quality mark for both RE teaching and Eco Schools. We create many enrichment opportunities, including visits, visitors and themed days as we believe that learning should be meaningful and memorable. Working together

Partnerships are integral to our school and help create our family ethos. We have inspiring School Council, Eco and Anti bullying groups. Older children flourish when they take on roles such as House Captains, Reading Buddies, Assembly Leaders and Sports Ambassadors.

We believe that working together with parents is key to success at primary school. There are many ways we encourage you, as parents, to become involved in your child's education. Each year we start with a "Meet the Teacher" evening giving information on what to expect in the year ahead and a chance to meet your child's new class teacher. Other events include, open book sessions, attending achievement assemblies, heart warming church services and regular parents' evenings.

A warm welcome awaits you and your child

We aim to make the transition to school as easy as possible. During the summer term, pupils and their parents visit the school to meet their teacher and become familiar with the surroundings.

The Early years' team may also visit your child's nursery.

In the first few weeks of term, our Reception teacher aims to visit new families at their homes to develop a greater understanding of each child.

For pupils joining the school in other year groups, our family worker runs a 'Passport programme' to help them settle in well.



How to join us

The admission number is 20 in Reception increasing to 26 at Year 3 (age 7+). We maintain good partnerships with local playgroups, nurseries and infant schools.

The catchment area for our Reception class follows the ecclesiastical boundary for Holmer Green and Penn Street. The catchment area for Year 3 entries also includes pupils from Coleshill CE Infant School catchment, who are able to apply to Curzon in the September following their seventh birthday.

Historically, due to the rural nature of the catchment area, many pupils reside outside the catchment area.

Applications for Reception and Year 3 are made via the Local Authority. As a Voluntary Aided school, the Governors are the school's Admission Authority. Applications for other year groups are to be made directly to the school.

For all applications the school also has an additional worship form for completion (where appropriate).
