APPEAL STAGE	DATE
National Offer Day applications (those received on time)	Monday 1 March
Deadline for <b>first round</b> secondary/middle school appeals (must give applicant 20 school days from date of refusal to prepare and lodge their appeal <sup>1</sup> )	Tuesday 30 March
Appeals will be heard (Must be heard within 40 school days of the deadline to lodge appeal <sup>2</sup> )	Between Tuesday 11 May and Friday 18 June
LATER APPLICATIONS WILL BE HEARD AS FOLLOWS:	Applicants must be given 20 school days to return and lodge their appeal. Within 40 school days of that date, their appeal will be heard.

**INFANT, PRIMARY & COMBINED SCHOOLS**

APPEAL STAGE	DATE
Primary National Offer Day applications (those received on time)	Friday 16 April
Deadline for <b>first round</b> infant/primary/combined appeals (must give applicant 20 school days from date of refusal to prepare and lodge their appeal)	Monday 17 May
Appeals will be heard (Must be heard within 40 school days of the deadline to lodge appeal <sup>3</sup> )	Between Friday 18 June and Thursday 22 July
LATER APPLICATIONS WILL BE HEARD AS FOLLOWS:	Applicants must be given 20 school days to return and lodge their appeal. Within 40 of that date, their appeal will be heard.

Applications for in-year admissions<sup>4</sup>, parents must be given 20 school days from the date of refusal to prepare and lodge their appeal. The appeal must be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.
